#### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 6 months of the event.

- ➤ Rabies vaccination between 30 days and 12 months for animals over 3 months of age.
- > Shipping fever vaccination between 14 days and 6 months prior to the event
- ➤ Out of f-state cattle imported into Vermont also require official individual identification and an import permit with a CVI dated within 30 days of entry, or a CVI issued for the six months duration of an exhibition permit. Call 802-828-2421 for a permit.

#### **CAVALCADE**

Cavalcade will be on Saturday, August 27, 2016 @ 11:30 Exhibitors myst participate; otherwise, pemiums will be forfeited.

#### **POT LUCK**

Our usual potluck, a time to and share good times and laughter, will be after chores on *Thursday evening* around 7:30. Exhibitors share a favorite dish.

#### **PASSES**

Passes will be issued as follows:

Exhibitors:

➤ A string of 1 to 6: Exhibitor receives one bracelet.

- ➤ A string of 6 and up receives two bracelets
- ➤ No exhibitor will be given two passes/bracelets without the other person being present.
- > The daily CCF exhibitor bracelet must be worn at all times.
- ➤ All exhibitors will wear a "Cattle Dept" snap on bracelet to be worn at all times.
- ➤ The above bracelet will allow cattle dept. exhibitors entrance in the gate.
- ➤ No "cattle dept" bracelet means you pay at the gate.
- > Youth exhibitor allows one daily CCF exhibitor bracelet for one parent.
- > Daily CCF exhibitor bracelets must be worn at all times.

Exceptions are at the discretion of the cattle superintendent or his or her designee.

If an exhibitor arrives after 5:00 pm on Wednesday, August 24th, the exhibitor must contact the superintendent to arrange for entrance passes; otherwise, the exhibitor will be required to pay entrance fees at the gate for which there no reimbursement

#### **CRITERIA FOR HERDSMAN JUDGING**

A herd of 6 or more qualifies for herdsman competition

No additional animals can be added to an other exhibitor's herd after 5 pm on Wednesday, August 24, 2016

**Education:** Does the exhibitor display educationhal materials prtaining to agriculture and do exhibitors act appropriately when askd questions about their education materials? *Maximium Points-40* 

**Cleanliness**: Does the exhibit appear to be clean and free of trash and other debris? Are animals clean and free of manure soiling? Are tools and feed stored appropriately and neat for viewing? *Maximum Points-25* 

**Exhibitor Appearance and Attitude:** Do the exhibitors display proper courtesy with the general public and are apprioriate with their behavior with each other? *Maximum Points-15* 

**Decorations:** Is the exhibit decorated appropriately for viewing by the general public? Are there adequate decorations for the exhibit? *Maximum Points- 10* 

**Exhibitor Participation:** Is there someone present at the exhibit to interact with the public and make sur animals ar fed and cleaned *Maximum Points-10* 

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. All 4-H Club members who show in the open classes for premiums must abide by the Rules and Regulations set up for the Cattle Department by the Fair Association.
- 2. All applications for entries must be made on printed forms and in accordance with printed instructions to indicate:

  A. Breed of Cattle

  B. Registered or Grade

  C. All sections entered
- 3. Exhibitors must have registration papers for each purebred animal exhibited available for inspection by an assigned cattle department official before animals enter the judging ring.
- 4. A group of 6 animals is considered a herd and may compete for the herdsman awards.
- 5. Do not make entries for championships. Only first prize winners in their respective lots shall be eligible to compete for championships.
- 6. Animals composing of a herd or group do not need to be named on the entry applications, but the animals to be composed as a group must be entered in the individual classes. Exhibitor must indicate the section numbers for which he desires to make entry in the herd or group classes. **NOTE**: As the time of showing either herds or groups, the exhibitor must supply ring clerk with name and registry number of the various animals in the herd or group. No premiums will be paid until this information is furnished.
- 7. The individual or farm exhibiting must own all cattle.
- 8. In the event that an exhibitor refuses to furnish necessary documentation and follow the rules and regulations, any or all premiums may be forfeited and the exhibitor barred from showing at future shows.
- 9. The management reserves to itself the right of decline entries before the opening day of the Fair.
- 10. At no time, will there be any unacceptable language and behavior. All exhibitors must express safety to their co-exhibitors and the public. If at any time that such behavior is generated, the superintendent reserves the right to expel an exhibitor from the fair, and if required, security will be called upon for assistance.
- 11. All animals show in the ring and their exhibitors must be ready when called, either for judging or the cavalcade. Failure to do so entails forfeiture of all premiums.
- 12. All ages of all animals must be given and verified when requested.
- 13. The judge may at his or her discretion require an animal to be milked before him in the ring.
- 14. The exhibitor must have owned all animals in the herd 30 days prior to the exhibition.
- 15. No one will be allowed in the ring during judging, except for judges and attendants with animals.
- 16. All animals entered for competition must be in their places no later than 5:00 pm on Wednesday evening, August 24, 2016. Entries placings will close at 5:00 pm.
- 17. All cattle are required to be present until 4:00 pm on Sunday evening of the Fair, unless released by the Superintendent.
- 18. A transfer of ownership for the purpose of exhibiting will debar an animal and operate against the premium.
- 19. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two premiums in any one class.
- 20. All animals are expected to participate in the cavalcade unless excused by the Superintendent.
- 21. Grand Champion award is awarded only if five or more compete for the breed champion.

Judges are instructed not to award prizes for animals that have not been identified or for animals that have been transferred on the records of the association to the exhibitor.

The Superintendent of cattle may examine the certificates of registry and transfers before prizes are awarded so that the Judge may know the exhibitors have compiled with these requirements. An unregistered animal,

even though eligible for registration or a registered animal not properly registered cannot compete in the registered classes.

All ribbons awarded by the judges will be displayed though out the Fair.

Official registration certificates properly transferred where necessary to show ownership of exhibitor shall be presented in support of all purebred livestock entries. Exception may be made on calves less than 6 months with papers pending, if so certified by exhibitor. Entries not supported in this manner may be subject to change and fail to qualify for premium award. The department superintendent shall rule the eligibility of any challenged entry. His or her decision is final.

The management assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to stock or equipment from any cause.

#### **CAMPING**

To reserve camper space, you must specify the size of your camper and confirm the date of arrival for an assigned camping space. Exhibitors reserving a camping space must park in the assigned location and keeping in mind to allow adequate space for your neighbors. If parking is inadequate to accommodate other exhibitors, you will be asked to move your camper. Due to space, only one camper per exhibitor, full extension of awnings may not be possible, no dogs allowed, no campfires allowed.

Electricity hook up: \$8.00 per night or \$30.00 for the week
Water hook up: \$8.00 per night or \$40.00 for the week
No utilities: \$7.00 per night or \$35.00 for the week.
