

CALEDONIA COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION CAMPER RULES AND REGULATIONS

Reservations:

1. **Reservations** will not be accepted without a completed reservation form along with full payment for the site. Please make check payable to the Caledonia County Fair Association Camping.
2. **Reservations** will be held until Wednesday morning of the fair.
3. We require your **camper's dimensions** as some sites vary in width and depth. If your site is not adequate you may move or rent additional space. Campers may have to choose between use of the slide out or awning.
4. You **must have a current camper registration form** in your camp window at all times.
5. **Exhibitors** – see Concessions manager.
6. **Camping prices** are subject to change without notice.
7. **The Caledonia County Fair Association takes no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please keep your vehicles locked.**

Camping area conduct:

Speed limit of 5 mph must be maintained at all times.

No dumping of gray water onto or into the ground.

Electrical panels will not be accessed or tampered with in any manner.

Garbage must be deposited in appropriate containers and not left outside of your camper.

No camp fires are allowed.

Quiet times are from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

All RV's must be self-contained. No restroom facilities are available.

No generators are to be used during these hours. Exception – Medical requirements as directed by your doctor.

Only one vehicle per campsite is allowed. Vehicle pass will be issued when registering and must be visually displayed on the dashboard. Be considerate of others space.

Dogs must be on a leash and are not allowed on the midway. Dog's which bark continuously and act aggressively will be removed from the fairgrounds.

Fair directors reserve the right to remove any animal. Owner assumes all risk and liability should injury occur.

Dog waste must be disposed of properly and immediately.

Dogs are not to be staked out without the owner being present.

You must be a licensed and insured driver to operate any motorized vehicle including scooters, cars and trucks.

Secure your valuables. Caledonia Fair is not responsible for property loss, theft or damage.

Campers must use their assigned sites and may not move sites without prior approval from the director of camping.

Alcohol may only be consumed by those 21 years of age or older in designated camping areas. Alcohol may not be carried onto the fairgrounds, which includes, but, is not limited to the midway, exhibit buildings or entertainment areas. Those found in violation of the camping rules will be asked to leave the grounds and will not receive a refund.

Arrangements for next day RV pumping may be made at the Secretary's Office. Pump out fee is presently 25.00.

This is not a long term RV lot. We reserve the right to limit the stay of any camper on the grounds.

Completion of the Campground Reservation Form and payment thereof constitutes acceptance of the rules and regulations by the adult in charge and all persons assigned using the assigned area.
