1. Registration open to ALL youth up to ages 18 (as of Jan 1, 2021). If enrolled in a 4-H goat project, specify club name on entry form.
2. Youth activities will take place daily Wednesday - Saturday, with the opportunity to compete at our ADGA Sr & Jr doe show on Sunday (premiums paid). Youth that house their goats at the fair Wed 8/25 - Sun 8/29 (encouraged) and participate in the Youth show (Sat) will receive \$50 *minimum* in premiums. Youth who conduct a demonstration/presentation in the goat tent during the fair will receive an additional \$50 in premiums! Goat-related, educational posters/displays = *MORE PREMIUMS!*
3. Animals shall be in place by Noon on Wed 8/25 and are released 4 PM on Sunday
4. All registered youth will automatically be signed up for a fun Sheep & Goat Quizbowl competition happening Wednesday at 4PM in the tent.
5. We understand that local school classes begin during our fair. In order to still allow youth to participate in the fair, the goat superintendent will be lining up (goat-experienced) help to cover morning chores for those youth, as to not interfere with their school schedule.
6. Exhibitors who stay the duration of the fair (Wed- Sun) are invited to participate in the ADGA sanctioned show Sunday morning for a *DISCOUNTED rate of only \$3 per doe entry!*
7. Dairy-type wethers may be shown in the appropriate Dairy Fitting & Showmanship class.
8. NO INTACT BUCKS ALLOWED
9. NO horned *dairy* goats. Small scurs that do not pose danger are acceptable. Meat breeds may be horned assuming they do not pose a danger to handler or other animals or damage fair property.
10. EVERY goat must have a form of visible permanent identification such as a tattoo or scrapies ear tag.
11. Grade and non-registered goats are eligible to enter this show.
12. All animals shown in group or special classes (draft) must have been shown in their regular classes in one of 2 divisions: Dairy **or** Meat
13. Base date to determine age is August 28.
14. **All Out-of-State animals must be accompanied by either a VT Exhibition Permit (good for 180 days) or VT Import Permit (good for 30 days). Permit may be obtained from the VT Dept of Agriculture, Food & Market 802-828-2421. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated within 30 days of request of a permit is required. Acceptable "Official ID" is a tattoo matched to registration papers.**
15. To reduce risk of disease, persons authorized by the show committee will visually inspect all goats upon arrival. Any goat exhibiting symptoms of pink eye, sore mouth, abscesses etc. will not be permitted to unload and it and all animals transported with it will be asked to exit the grounds, forfeiting entry fees.
16. Cleaning of pens daily is expected so that area is always presentable. All feed, hay & feeding equipment is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
17. Daily milking will take place at 6 PM. Milk is to be contained in buckets/jars and removed from the tent to prevent potential spread of contagious disease.
18. Entry fees are \$2 per goat.
