Agriculture and Conservation Day at Caledonia County Fair Wednesday, August 25, 2021

CCF is extending an invitation to all Day Care and Graded School students to attend an agriculture and conservation outing at the Fairgrounds on Wednesday, August 25, 2021. CCF will offer stations where students will be introduced to various animals, exhibits, and displays; each station (or stop) will last for 15 minutes before moving on to the next station. At 10:45 a representative from the Vt. Institute of Natural Science in Quechee will make a 45 minute presentation on reptiles, birds and raptors to all in attendance.

The program will start at 8:45 a.m. with registration and will conclude at 11:30 a.m. Participants will be divided into six groups with each group having a host or guide who will accompany the assigned groups to all presentations.

Rides will NOT be in operation, nor will vendors be open; this event is intended to be an educational experience offering a hands-on experience for the participant; there is NO charge for the event. Parents and adults may join the presentations, if desired. Participants are expected to leave the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the event.

No student may attend the event without a signed permission slip; this slip should accompany the student the day of the event.
